Here are some helpful reminders to add to your to-do list:

•Annual Mobile Home Registration Renewal: Each home in the community must have a current annual license. Residents must comply with all applicable state and local laws, ordinances, and regulations regarding their home and necessary buildings. If your annual registration is not up to date, please contact the Florida Department of Motor Vehicles at (321) 264-6935 to renew it. Once you receive your updated registration, provide a copy to the Business Office for your resident file.

◆Oversized Waste Disposal: If you have over sized waste or items that cannot be picked up during the regular garbage schedule, you can contact Waste Management at (321) 723-4455 to arrange for pickup.


• Exciting News!

Join and play when you like or come play with others on fundays. Fees are only \$6 for the year. Contact Sue Gilbert (treasurer) 513-594-2258 for more details.



















Square Dance EVERY Sunday night in March 6:00 to 7:30 pm or so.


Nat King Cole died of Lung cancer at the young age of 45.
